A leader in this role will build the Clinical Team from the ground up, developing the practice, protocols, and procedures to operate a highly reliable, highly effective clinical oversight model.

You will deliver effective remote therapeutic monitoring services, develop and refine workflow and protocols related to these clinical services, and work with Mightier leadership to create best-in-class provider and member experiences.

- As the Clinical Team grows, you will hire, train, supervise, and develop clinicians through role-modeling, coaching, feedback, and training.
- Define goals and metrics for the Clinical Team that are aligned to clear business and clinical outcomes.
- Work with Mightier Leadership to understand specific requirements and alternative workflows related to specific provider partners.
- Establish ongoing monitoring processes to track the operational health of the team, including staffing needs and caseloads.
- Develop and refine protocols, policies, and procedures to ensure efficiency and consistency in care.
- Be the voice of clinicians and clients by communicating needs to leadership and tracking service implementations to ensure high-quality, effective, compliant, patient-centered care delivery.
